WHAT IS THE HOME MODIFICATION PROGRAM?

Ability360's Home Modification Program assists people with disabilities who need modifications to their residence improve to accessibility and safety.

The program facilitates structural modifications for Maricopa County residents.

The Home Modification Program is made possible by Community Development Block Grants. Additional funding may be possible through ALTCS, ILS, VA and HUD. Private pay services are also available.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

This is a match program. You are expected to pay 10% of the cost of the modification through cash, in-kind contribution (materials or volunteerism), or through other funding contributions.

Due to funding limitations, there is a dollar limit on each modification.

WHO IS QUALIFIED FOR THE PROGRAM?

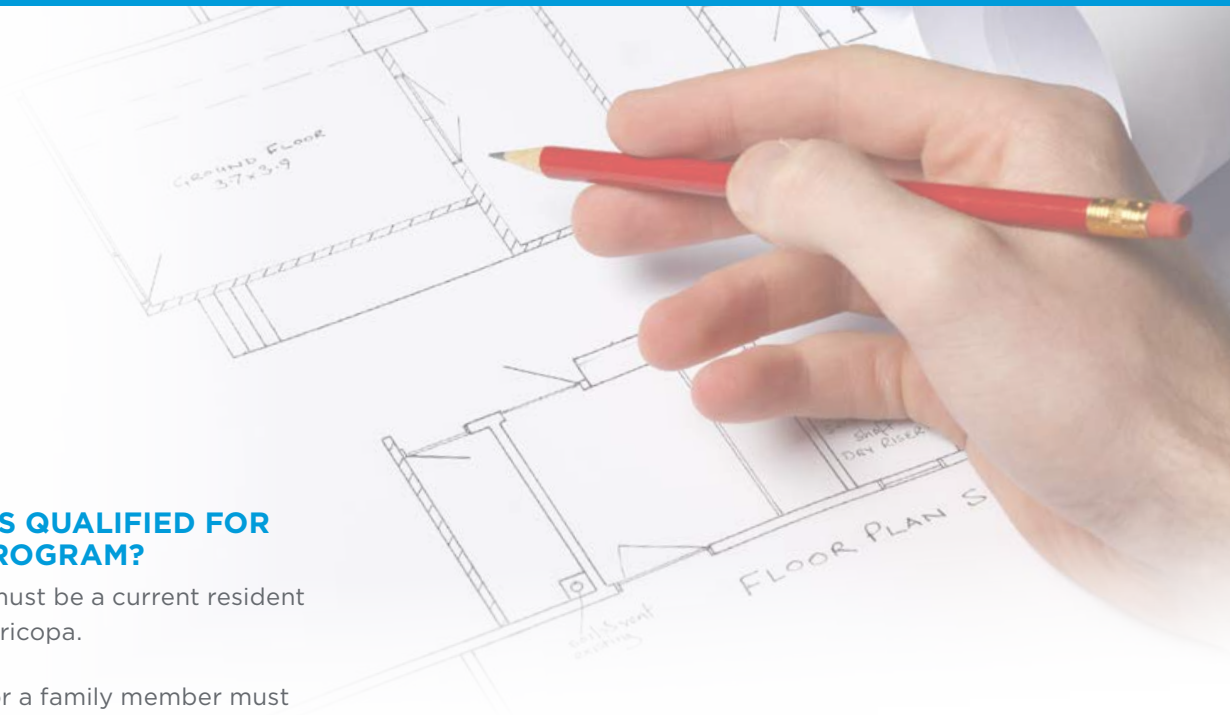
- You must be a current resident of Maricopa.
- You or a family member must have a physical disability.

WHAT KIND OF HOME MODIFICATIONS CAN BE DONE?

We can assist with a wide variety of basic modifications that increase the accessibility in your home and increase the independence of one or more of the residents with a disability.

Typical modifications include:

- Ramps
- Widened door openings
- Grab bars
- Modified sinks & toilets
- Relocated electrical switches

HOW DO I APPLY FOR THE PROGRAM?

Contact an Ability360 Home Modification Coordinator to apply: (602) 256-2245.

A Home Modification Program Coordinator will conduct an interview to assess what home modifications would assist your independence and make recommendations. The Coordinator will also make referrals for other services that may be beneficial.

Services to qualified applicants shall be provided without regard for disability, race, color, sex, religion, ancestry or age. Reasonable accommodations will be made for persons with disabilities.
